I, _____, hereafter referred to as the Foster, agree
(PRINT FULL NAME) to abide by the following terms set forth by
Whiskey Ridge Rescue (WRR) in regards to fostering the horse described above.

»» _____ You agree to hold harmless Whiskey Ridge Rescue (WRR), its Directors, Board Members, Officers, Coordinators, Members, or Volunteers, from and against all liability, causes of action, suits, demands, judgments and claims of any nature whatsoever arising from, by reason of, or in connection with said horse.

»» _____ You assume total responsibility for the care of the horse you are fostering. You are responsible for providing food, water, and shelter daily and as much as needed.

»» _____ You agree to set up routine farrier visits for trimming and/or shoeing needs. You agree to set up routine veterinarian appointments for vaccinations, etc. In addition, you agree to provide routine dentals (teeth floats) yearly or as directed by a professional equine dentist and/or veterinarian.

»» _____ Your fostered equine is the property of WRR and may not be sold, leased, given away, assigned or disposed of, or have any interest in thereof transferred.

»→ _____ Our experience is that many foster homes end up adopting their fostered equine. You agree that you have two weeks from the time the equine is placed in your care to decide if you want to adopt the equine and three days to submit the application for adoption. After that time, the equine is available for adoption to an approved applicant.

»→ _____ In the case of an emergency, please contact one of WRR's Board Members to inform them of the situation and to discuss what action is to be taken. If you feel that the horse's life is at stake, call a veterinarian first and then call WRR. Email and/or messenger contact information can be found through our website or Facebook page. In addition, if in an emergency you are unable to reach a Board Member, please work together with the veterinarian to make the appropriate decisions.

»→ _____ You hereby understand any expense incurred while fostering a WRR horse is tax deductible when paid for by you. You are responsible for feed, farrier, vetting and routine care costs, unless it is a pre-approved expense as discussed with WRR Board Members.

»→ _____ You agree to provide a weekly report to the WRR Board Members to let them know the status of the horse, how the horse is doing, or any concerns or questions you may have, along with photos, or as requested. This includes informing the Board of any and all changes in location of the equine.

»→ _____ You agree to work with WRR's Board Members in placing your foster horse into its WRR approved permanent home. This will include, but may not be limited to, talking with prospective adopters, showing the horse to prospective adopters, etc.

»→ _____ You will not breed your fostered equine nor cause it to be branded, or any additional permanent alterations to your fostered equine..

»→ _____ WRR makes no representations or guarantees about the soundness, abilities, temperament or health of the equine. You agree to accept all responsibility for any action or lien resulting from any action, directly or indirectly involving your fostered equine while it is in your care, and you agree that neither WRR nor its employees or agents will be liable for any damages or injury caused to you or any third person by your fostered equine once you receive delivery of the equine, including but not limited to damages or injuries caused by the fact that the equine does not behave or perform in the manner expected. If any third person makes a claim against WRR or any of its employees or agents as a result of any conduct of the equine in your possession, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless WRR its directors, officers, employees and agents from any such claim, including costs and attorney's fee resulting from such claim.

➡ _____ This agreement shall be legally binding upon you and/or as the parents or legal guardians of a minor, your heirs, estate, assigns, including all minor children, and personal representatives; and it shall be interpreted according to the laws of the state of Missouri and county of Pettis, being the WRR principle location. Any dispute under this agreement shall be litigated in and venue shall be the State of Missouri and the County of Pettis. If any clause, phrase or word is in conflict with state law, then that single part is null and void.

➡ _____ You understand that WRR will immediately proceed with legal action against you should any attempt be made on your part to deny immediate access to the equine upon a request by a representative of WRR or for any violation of any terms of this agreement. Should you deny or fail to provide immediate access to your fostered equine when requested you will bear all costs of enforcement of this agreement.

By signing both the Foster Contract, I declare all of the information I have submitted to be the truth, to the best of my knowledge, and if found to be fraudulent, that I will be denied approval of adoption and I could be held liable. I have read and understand the above terms of this contract and agree to all of them.
